Menopause Awareness for HR Professionals and Line Managers



This half-day workshop provides an insight for HR Professionals and Line Managers into how menopause transition can impact on people's lives and careers.

#### Overview

The workshop considers the legal implications for line managers and organisations, and explores good practice in supporting women during this time in their lives and beyond. In talking about the menopause, it helps to remove the taboo which surrounds it, enabling constructive conversations to take place.

- To increase understanding of the menopause for line managers and HR professionals, and the impact it has for individuals and organisations.
- To explore potential steps that organisations can take to support women experiencing the menopause, thereby retaining their skills and talents.
